## Historical Note

Edward Samuel "Tige" Reynolds (1877-1931) was born in Oskaloosa, Iowa, and relocated to California in 1892. Reynolds married Mary Irene Brunton, in Fresno, Fresno County, California on June 14, 1903.

He worked as a newspaper cartoonist for the San Francisco *Post*, Fresno *Evening Democrat*, Tacoma *Ledger*, and from 1911 to 1931 for the *Oregonian*. He was known as "Tige" Reynolds.
