The Office of Housing creates and sustains affordable living for low-income residents. Events such as the Notice of Funding Availability grant awards for development of low-income housing are pictured, as well as affordable housing developed by local non-profits such as South East Effective Development, Housing Resources Group, Comapss Center, Delridge Neighborhoods Development Association, Plymouth Housing Group, Low Income Housing Institute, Interim Community Development Association, and Capitol Hill Housing Improvement Program.
