Carl Barnett Allendoerfer was born 1911. Allendoerfer was a professor of mathematics, chairman of the Mathematics Department and of the Faculty Senate. He originated the Summer Mathematics Institute for High School Teachers at University of Washington. He was president of the Mathematical Association of America, and developed the "new math" curriculum for primary and secondary schools.
