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## Historical Note

Joseph Lane, first Territorial Governor of Oregon, Territorial delegate to Congress, and U.S.

Senator, was born in North Carolina in 1801. His family moved to Kentucky when he was a

young man, and Lane later went on to Indiana, where he married Mary (Polly) Hart in 1820 and became active in politics. Distinguishing himself in the Mexican War, he was eventually appointed by President James K. Polk to be the first governor of the Oregon Territory, arriving in Oregon City on March 2, 1849. Known for his good relations with the Cayuse and Rogue River Indians, Lane was recognized as

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the principal architect of the peace treaty with the Rogue River Indian tribal chiefs, which was signed at Table Rock in September 1853.

On June 18, 1850, Lane resigned his governorship and was soon elected Oregon

delegate to Congress, a position he held until 1859. While in Congress he advocated policies of economic growth, peace with the Indians, postal reform, and internal improvements for Oregon, as well as amendments to the Oregon donation land law. When Oregon was admitted to the Union on February 14, 1859, Joseph Lane and Delazon Smith became the first of the state's U.S. Senators. Lane remained in the Senate until his retirement on March 3, 1861.

After attempting to secure the Democratic presidential nomination in 1852, and again in 1856, Lane was selected as the vice-presidential candidate in 1860 on the John Breckinridge Democratic ticket, which did not oppose Confederate secession. After the ticket's defeat, Lane lost his political support in Oregon and announced his retirement from public life. He spent his last twenty years on his farm near Roseburg, Oregon.

## Content Description

Papers include: correspondence (1848-1875) received during Lane's service as Oregon's delegate to Congress; territorial proclamations (1847-1849); copies of letters written by Lane (1848-1861); photocopy of report (1849) to the U.S. secretary of war concerning the customs and locations of various Indian tribes in the Oregon Territory; mailing lists (1848-1859) of Lane's constituents when he held public office; survey of Lane's Donation Land Claim; orders, reports, and requisitions created while Lane served in the Mexican War; and documents (1849-1851) related to the Rogue River Indian wars and Whitman Massacre. Correspondents include George Abernethy, Benjamin Alvord, Jesse Applegate, George Atkinson, William Blain, Francis Norbert Blanchet, Reuben Patrick Boise, John Breckenridge, William P. Bryant, Asahel Bush, Jefferson Davis, Matthew Paul Deady, Addison Crandall Gibbs, La Fayette Grover, Amory Holbrook, John Webster Perit Huntington, John McBride, Joseph Meek, James Nesmith, Joel Palmer, O. C. Pratt, Delazon Smith, J. Quinn Thornton, and Elijah White. Subjects discussed within the correspondence include Indian affairs, the seat of government controversy (1852), partition of Oregon Territory, political appointments, veterans' pensions, Lane's presidential candidacy in 1852 and 1856, and proposed amendments to the Oregon Donation Land Act.
