## Historical Note

The Central Seattle Community Council Federation represents a merger of the Central Area Community Council and the Jackson Street Community Council. The merger was formally approved in February 1967.

The Jackson Street Community Council was formed in 1946 under United Good Neighbors (UGN) sponsorship to serve the needs of Seattle's International Area. The "self-help" approach of the Jackson Street Community Council, in combination with UGN support, proved to be extremely effective, and as a result of its success, the Jackson Street Community Council received wide national attention as a paradigm of this type of organization.

The Central Area Community Council was formed in 1962 as a volunteer organization designed to bring together representatives from all of the neighborhood and service organizations serving the Central District. The Central Area Motivation Program (CAMP) resulted from a proposal submitted to the Office of Economic Opportunity by this organization. The Central Seattle Community Council was formed to combine the area-wide representation of the Central Area Community Council with the intensive staff support of the Jackson Street Community Council.

## Content Description

Correspondence, financial records, reports, subject files, and committee files of the Central Seattle Community Council Federation (1958-1984) and the Jackson Street Community Council (1945-1969). Major correspondents include the National Health & Welfare Retirement Association, the Seattle Urban Renewal Enterprise, Community Chest and Council of Seattle and King County, Health and Welfare Council of Seattle and King County, Neighborhood House Inc., and the National Federation of Settlements and Neighborhood Centers.

Scope and Content: This accession includes records of both the Central Seattle Community Council (1967-1971) and the Jackson Street Community Council (1945-1969). Records include correspondence, financial records, subject files, committee files, and files of other community councils affiliated with the Central Seattle Community Council and the Jackson Street Community Council.
