Eula Victoria Ledgerwood Jesseph was born on September 18, 1902. She attended Whitman College, class of 1924. She died on June 9, 1988.

Content Description

The Eula Ledgerwood Papers, which date from 1920 through 1923, contain a scrapbook of items related to student life at Whitman College, especially sorority life. The collection also includes dance souvenirs and other ephemera, a booklet on Whitman College Women's Association Self-Government, a poster of "Regulations governing conduct of freshmen women," photographs, and programs from various Whitman theatrical and musical productions.
