Biographical Note

Rick Page is a local Salt Lake City filmmaker. In addition to writing and directing his own short films, Page has worked as a cameraman on numerous television shows and movies filmed in the Salt Lake City area, including *Touched by an Angel*, *Legally Blonde 2* (Charles Herman-Wurmfeld 2003), *High School Musical 3* (Kenny Ortega 2008) and over 50 others.

"Water With Food Coloring"Originally shot on 35mm film, this short piece was filmed in Salt Lake City by the crew of <i>Touched by an Angel</i> on their days off. Directed by Page, this piece is a spoof of the rigamarole of filmmaking. The piece features some of the cast and crew of <i>Touched by an Angel</i> in supporting roles. 16:00.2.
